Architectural Reviews

The Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, Reservations and Restrictions (the "Deed Restrictions") for the different Phases of Saddle Creek Subdivision specify all improvements and variances, as defined in the Deed Restrictions, must be approved, in writing, by the Architectural Control Team (ACT) before an Improvement begins. To assist your compliance with this restriction, below is a list of required information to be forwarded to the ACT for the proposed action.

Serve the Neighborhood - Volunteer.

Want to help out in the neighborhood but don't know how. There are several neighborhood Teams you can volunteer to be a part of:

Architecture Control Team – oversees the changes and modifications to property.

Pavilion & Swimming Pool Team – Responsible for the upkeep of pool, pavilion, ice machine, refrigerator and grill.

Neighborhood Improvement Team – Maintaining nature trail, entrance, athletic field. Identify problems with country roads, stop sign and yard of the month.

Neighborhood Outreach Team – Works with the County, Sheriff. Keep up with homes for sale, welcome new neighors.

Event Planning Team – Budget and plan for neighborhood events.

The ACT is looking for volunteers

The ACT, like the rest of the HOA functions, operates by the effort and good will of member volunteers. The ACT has 5 members, and the HOA board is soliciting volunteers who wish to serve.

The ACT oversees changes and modifications to property in accordance with the CCR. It acts through an application and appeal process designed to balance the interests of individual homeowners and the community as a whole, ensuring guidelines are met and property values are protected.

THE ACT

- Manages the improvement application and approval process
- •Enforces standards set forth in the governing documents (CC&R) through that process
- •Makes subjective and objective decisions about guideline compliance for improvements on properties
- Makes recommendations to the board of directors
- •Reviews guidelines for adequacy
- Educates the community about guidelines

The ACT will have 5 members, except that we will ask members who are rotating off to stay on long enough to help the transition. Prefer individuals who are willing to serve a minimum two year term.
