Saddle Creek – Board of Directors

Are you interested in serving on the Saddle Creek Board of Directors? There are two BOD positions up for election this December. Applications will be emailed out (or mailed if you don't have an email address on file). That will happen sometime around November 1st. Beal will also post the application to the Beal Saddle Creek Website. BOD elections will be held on Dec 12, 2023 at our Annual Meeting of the Members. Voting Options listed below.



Voting Options: Important: ONE vote per lot/household.

1. Vote in person at the Annual Meeting. Person voting must be listed on the property deed or must have a signed proxy authorizing them to vote on behalf of the legal owner.

2. Vote online via Election Buddy link - If you are unable to attend but would like to vote, you can vote via Election Buddy. A secure link will be emailed to you and once clicked, a security password will be sent to your cell phone. If you do not receive one or both, please contact Lara Lewis and she will update your account and resend the link.

3. Vote via Absentee Ballot - You can complete the Absentee Ballot. Ballots must have each page completely filled out and signed. You can email to laral@bealbcs.com, or mail, or deliver in person to Beal Properties, 3363 University Drive East, Suite 215, Bryan 77802. Mail must be postmarked by December 6th, or ballot must be emailed or delivered by December 12th, 2023 end of business. If you need a ballot, you can download it from the website, www.bealbcshoa.com

4. Vote via Proxy - If you are not planning to attend the Annual Meeting in person, or voting via absentee ballot/Election Buddy, but would like someone to cast your vote in your absence, you MUST sign and date a PROXY and send it to the meeting with the designated person. The person signing must be listed on the property deed. If a spouse is not listed on the deed, they WILL need a proxy to cast a vote. If you are naming a current Director or Beal Properties as your Proxy, your form MUST be emailed, mailed or delivered in person to Beal Properties, 3363 University Drive East, Suite 215, Bryan 77802. Mail must be postmarked by December 6th, or form must be emailed or delivered by December 12th, 2023, end of business. 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Halloween Safety

Watch out for traffic – drivers might not see you.
